SF-182 Math Writing Instruction One-Day Training

Synopsis: This one day session provides participants with the knowledge of how to teach writing in the mathematics classroom in order to meet the writing expectations set forth in the Common Core State Standards. - Increase teacher ability to provide quality writing instruction that supports math content learning.
