SF-182 Writing Assessment One Day Training

Synopsis: This one day session provides participants with the knowledge of how to use rubrics to assess student writing, as well as how to use student writing as formative assessment to guide writing instruction in order to meet the writing expectations set forth in the Common Core State Standards.
